Independence residents who are unable to deliver their debris to the park due to physical limitations may call the Independence Police Department @ (503)838-1214 by May 20, 2016 to request pick up. Monmouth residents who are unable to deliver their debris to the park due to physical limitations may call the Monmouth Public Works Department @ (503)838-2173 by May 20, 2016 to request pick up, please ask for Shannon. We will NOT pick up for able bodied residents and items need to be placed near the curb.
